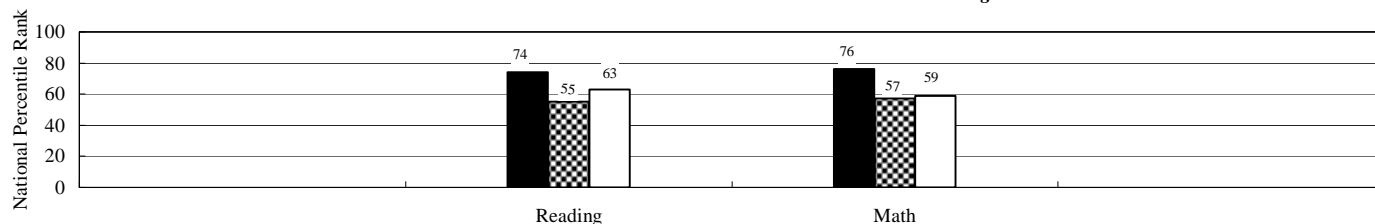

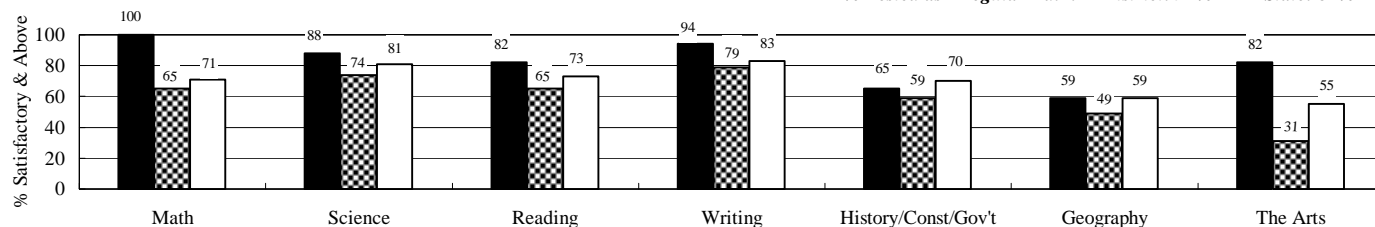
### 3rd Grade Stanford Achievement Tests, 9th Edition - "Regular Ed." Students

% Tested as "Regular Ed.": District: 92% State: 83%



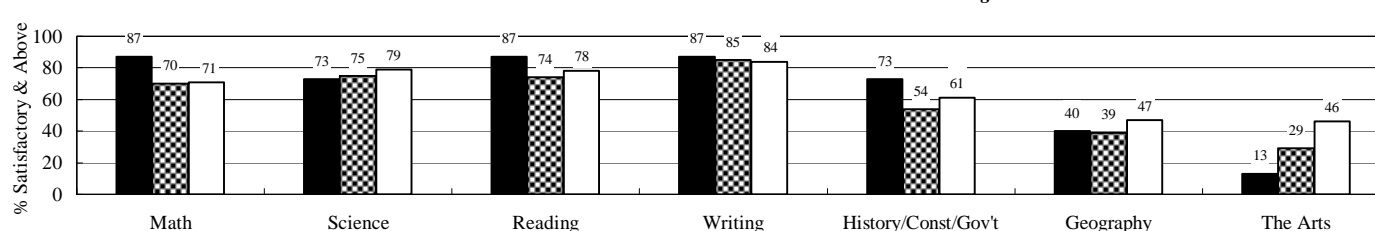
### 5th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test - "Regular Ed." Students

% Tested as "Regular Ed.": District: 94% State: 82%



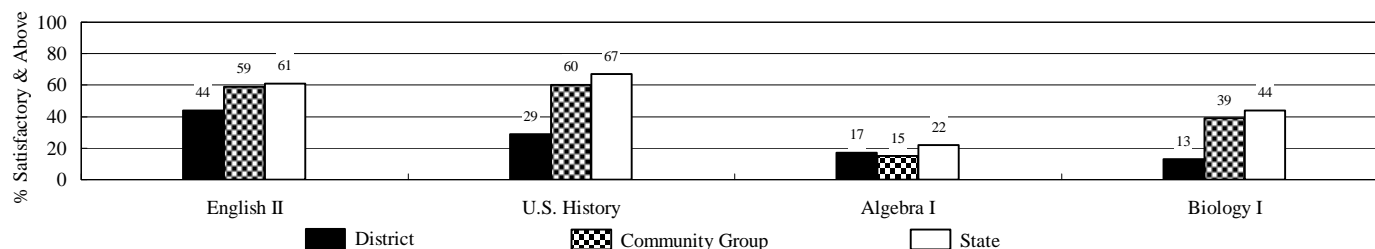
### 8th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test - "Regular Ed." Students
