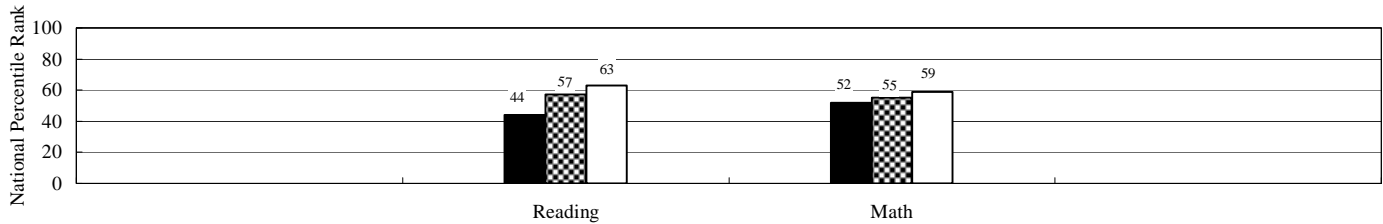

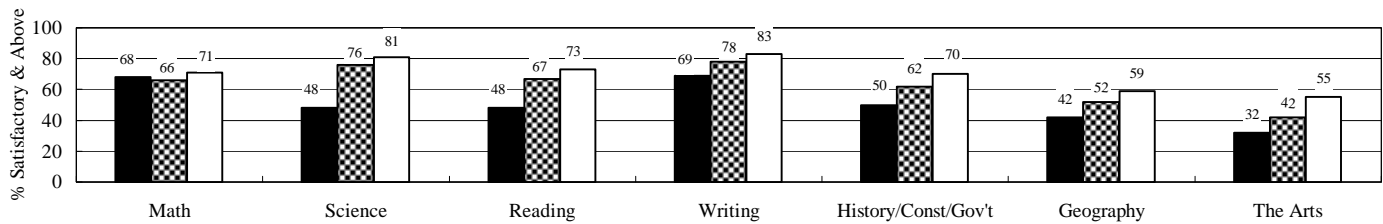
3rd Grade Stanford Achievement Tests, 9th Edition - "Regular Ed." Students

% Tested as "Regular Ed.": District: 76% State: 83%



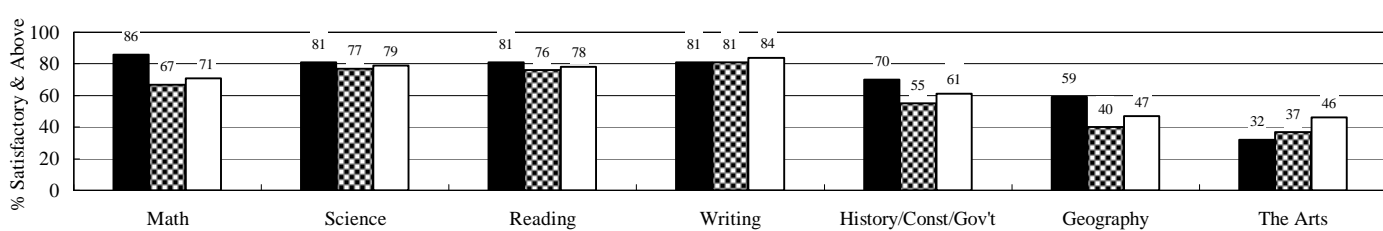
5th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test - "Regular Ed." Students

% Tested as "Regular Ed.": District: 78% State: 82%



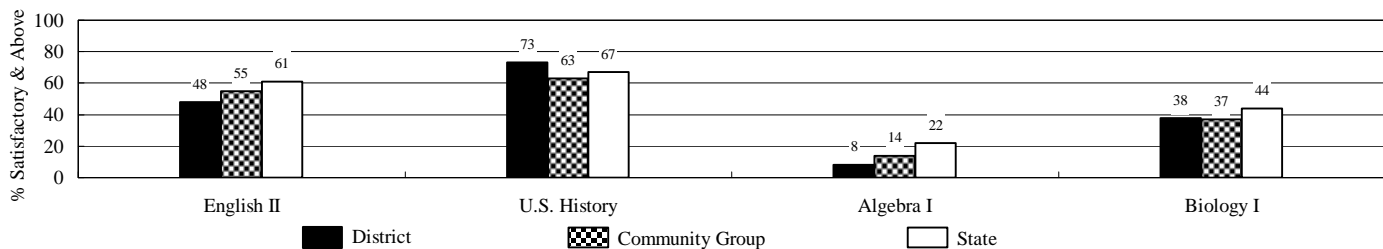
8th Grade Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test - "Regular Ed." Students
