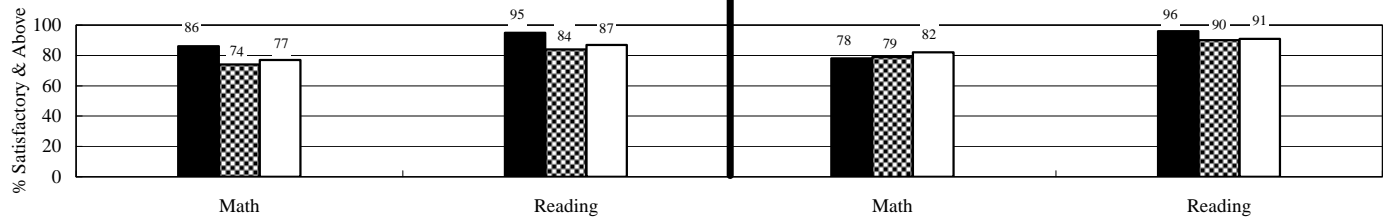

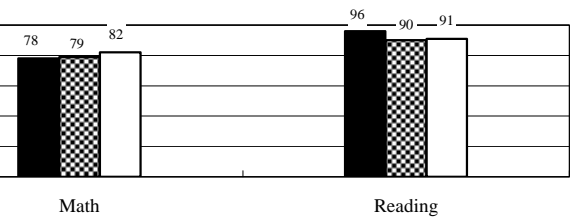

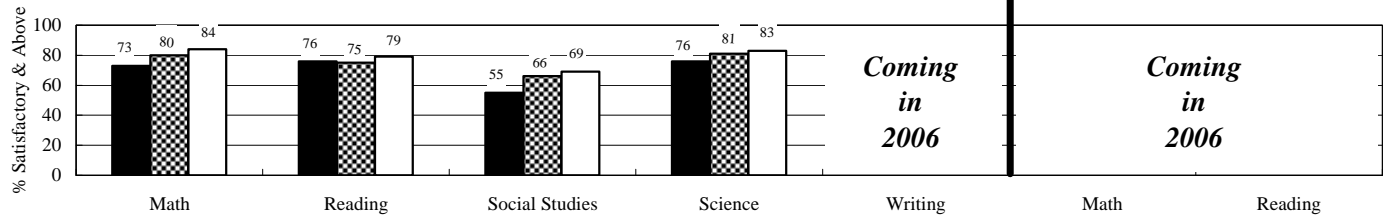
### 3rd Grade Tests \*



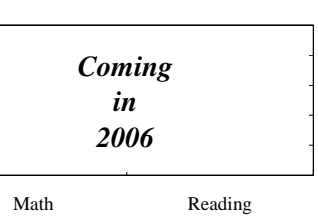
### 4th Grade Tests \*



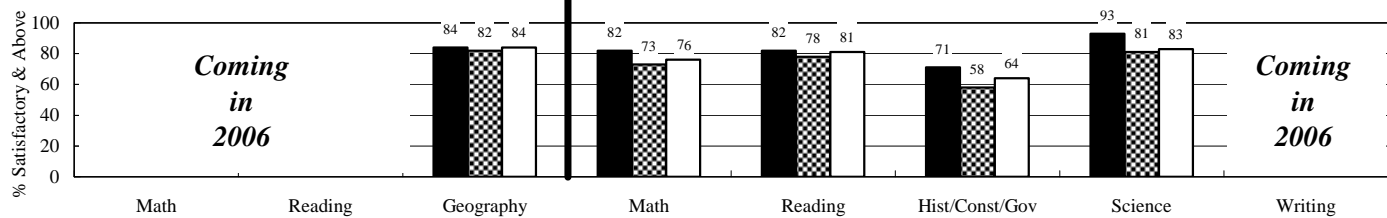
### 5th Grade Tests \*



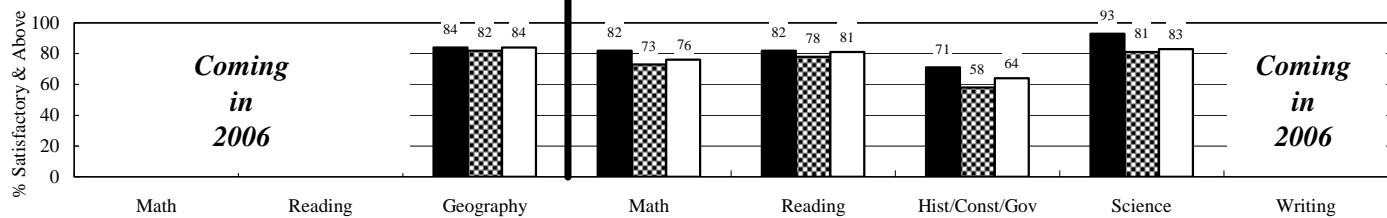
### 6th Grade Tests \*

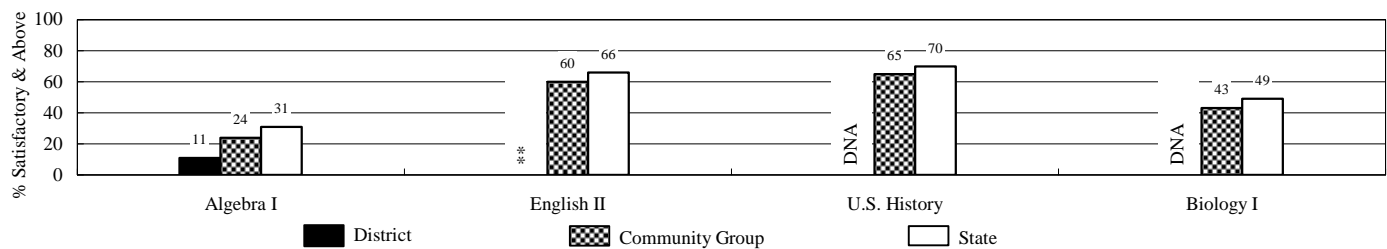
