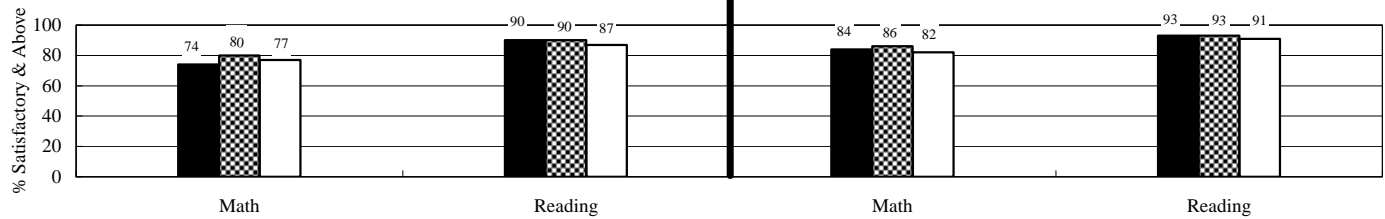

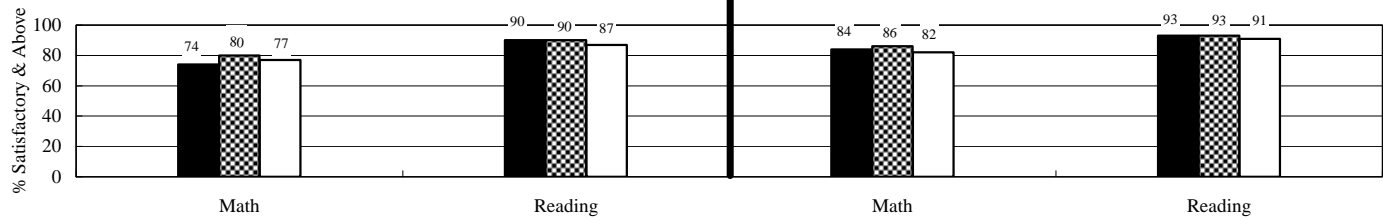

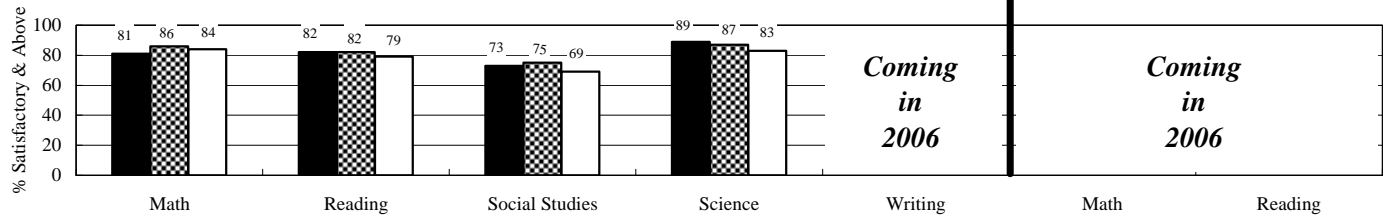
## 3rd Grade Tests \*



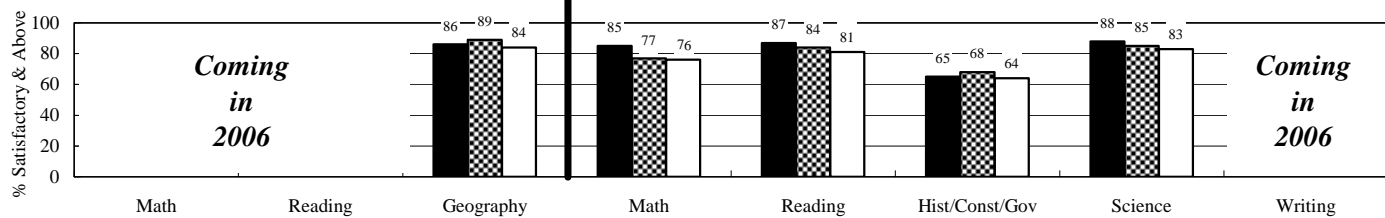
## 4th Grade Tests \*



## 5th Grade Tests \*

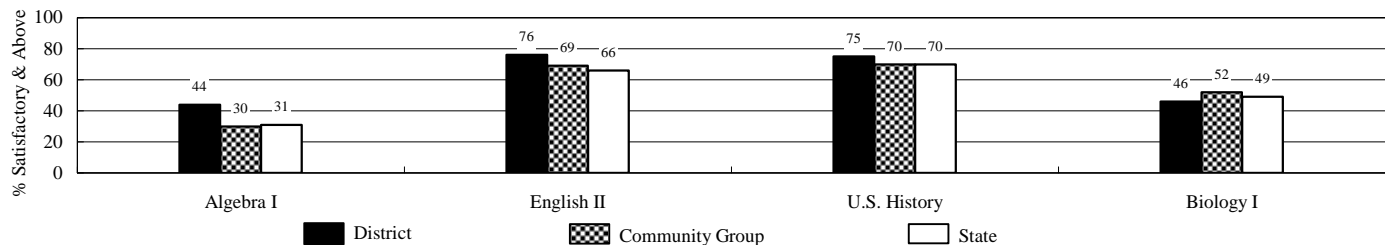
