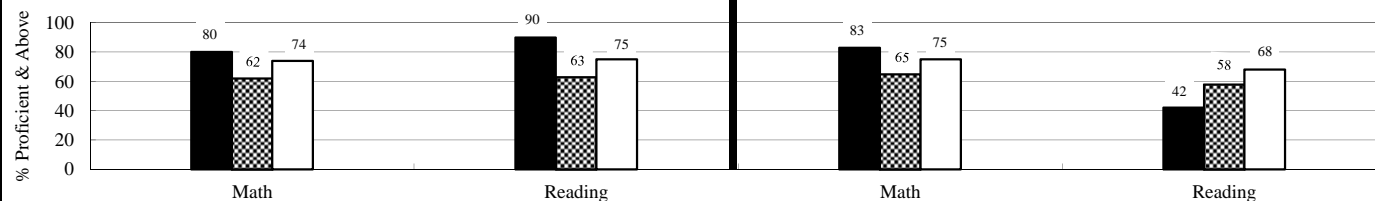

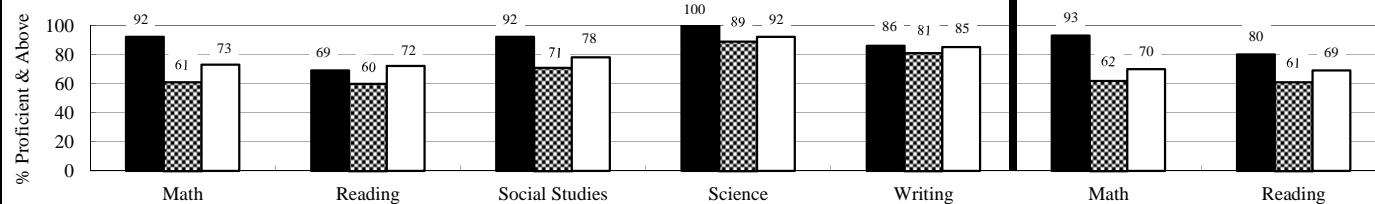
## 3rd Grade Tests\*



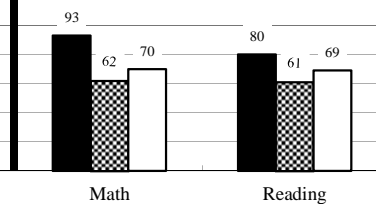
## 4th Grade Tests\*



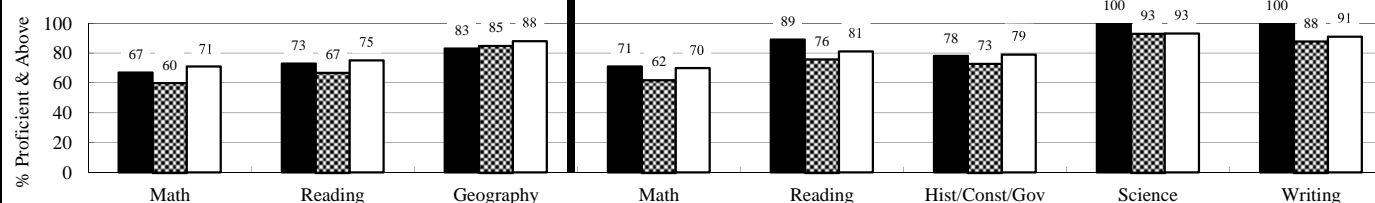

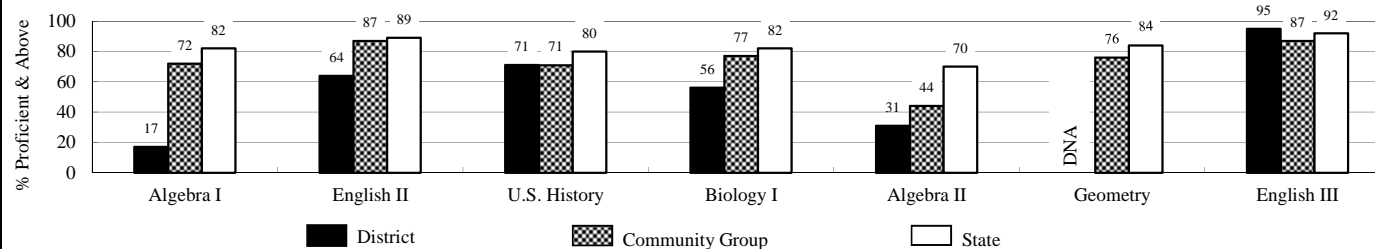
